TAKE CARE OF THE ESSENTIALS

We help people meet their basic needs for food, clothing, shelter and transport so that vulnerable individuals can take control of their lives.



\$5 a week

(\$260/year) An organization can help a person keep his or her home and avoid ending up on the street.

SUPPORT YOUTH SUCCESS

We provide support to families, foster early childhood learning and encourage kids to stay in school so they can achieve their dreams.



\$10 a week

(\$520/year) An organization provides 25 pregnant immigrants in vulnerable situations with a maternity kit.

BREAK SOCIAL ISOLATION

We help the elderly, immigrants, and people living with disabilities and mental illness find their place in our community, make connections, and realize their full potential.



\$1 a day

(\$365/year) Thirty adults and children go home with a complete grocery basket and five (5) meals cooked in collective kitchens.

BUILD CARING COMMUNITIES

We improve the quality of life in our neighborhoods by fostering volunteerism and strengthening skills and leadership in local organizations.



\$20 a week

(\$1040/year) Eight (8) young people aged 6 to 12 who have a parent with a mental health problem can take part in group workshops to help demystify the illness, spend a pleasant moment with other young people in similar situations and answer their questions in a climate of trust and respect.
