PROVIDING ESSENTIAL NEEDS

We help people meet basic needs—food, clothing, housing, and transportation—so they can get back control over their lives.



\$5 a week
(\$260/year) an organization can help a person keep his or her home and avoid ending up on the street.

BREAKING SOCIAL ISOLATION

We help seniors, immigrants and people living with disabilities or mental illness find connection, belonging, and opportunities to thrive in our community.



\$1 a day
(\$365/year) an organization offers 73 psychosocial meetings to support vulnerable people who are going through a situation of crisis, psychological distress, or anxiety.

CREATING CARING, INCLUSIVE COMMUNITIES

We help revitalize neighbourhoods by encouraging others to volunteer and by strengthening the skills and leadership of the agencies that serve them.



\$10 per week
(\$520 per year) an organization can help one hundred people plan their budget by providing them with a free annual budgeting guide.

SUPPORTING YOUTH SUCCESS

We support families, nurture early childhood development, and encourage young people to stay in school and pursue their dreams, and take action towards preventing homelessness.



\$20 a week
(\$1040/year) an organization arranges eight (8) mornings for fathers and their children aged three (3) to six (6) where they share a free breakfast and a creative activity, strengthening their bond while breaking isolation.
